I – Translate into English:

1. Le rôle de la presse est d'informer, d'enquêter et de diffuser les nouvelles. /2

The role of the press is to inform, investigate and spread news.

2. Un journaliste devrait être impartial et ne devrait pas mettre son nez dans la vie privée des gens. /2

A journalist / newspaperman should be unbiased / unprejudiced and should not poke his nose into people's privacy.

3. Ses articles doivent présenter un intérêt pour le public sans nuire à la réputation du journal ou sinon, on pourrait lui faire un procès. /2.5

His articles must be newsworthy without harming the paper's reputation or else / otherwise, it could be sued / one could sue it.

4. D'après l'annonce de notre envoyé spécial, 5 personnes seraient mortes dans un accident d'avion. /2.5

According to our special correspondent's / reporter's announcement / report, five people / persons are reported to be dead in a plane accident.

5. Mais certains reportages, pour sensibiliser l'opinion publique, ne respectent pas la morale journalistique et ne protègent pas le droit à la vie privée. /3

But some / certain coverages, to sensitize public opinion, don't respect newspaper ethics and don't protect the right to privacy.

II – Give the words corresponding to the following definitions :

1. to give bad information about someone which is not true : **to libel / defame**

2. someone who reports news for newspapers, television, or radio, usually from another country: **foreign correspondent**

3. to examine books, documents, or films and remove parts of them that are offensive or not allowed by rules: **to censor**

4. someone who is in charge of a newspaper or magazine: **the chief editor**

5. to keep something secret, especially from the public, because it could cause embarrassment or trouble: **to hush up / to cover**

6. to give new or secret information to someone: **to disclose**

7. to give or allow someone the right to meet another person, usually in an official way: **to grant an interview**

8. showing unfair support for or opposition to someone or something because of your personal opinions: **to be biased / prejudiced**
